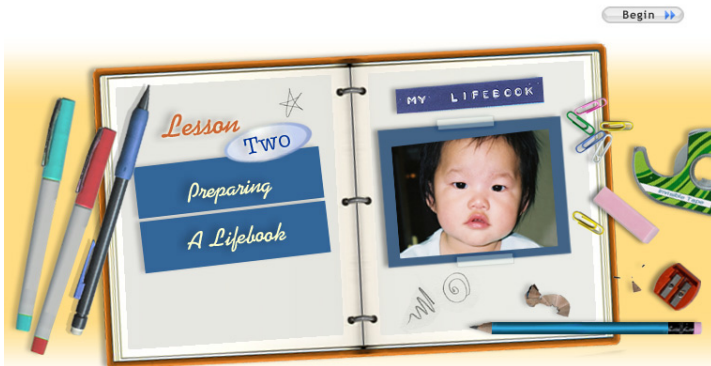

Frequently Asked Questions

I want to take an Adoption Learning Partners (ALP) course. What do I do?

- Click on the “register” link to create an account with ALP.
- If you registered previously, login with your username and password.

Is there a charge for courses?

- Enrollment for most ALP courses is free of charge. Certificates of completion are available for \$30 per course.
- There is a \$30 enrollment fee for With Eyes Wide Open, but there is no additional charge for a certificate of completion.

How do I pay for a certificate?

- Online with a Visa or MasterCard or by check payable to Adoption Learning Partners, 2049 Ridge Avenue, Evanston, IL 60201

Can my spouse/partner and I complete courses together?

- If your adoption agency allows you and your spouse/partner to complete courses together, select “joint registration”. One certificate is issued that includes both names.
- If you are required to complete the courses independent of your spouse/partner, select “individual registration.” The certificate is issued with one name.

How long do I have to take a course?

- There is no time limit. You may return to finish and/or review courses whenever you wish.

How do I get a certificate?

- You apply from your myALP page on the website. Your certificate will be available to you to download, print or email from your myALP page within seven days after receipt of your application.

Do I have to apply for a certificate immediately?

- No. Once you complete a course you can apply for a certificate at any time.

My adoption agency needs a copy of my certificate.

- Once your certificate has been issued, it is available on your myALP page and can be emailed anywhere.
